

Wagon Tracks submission guidelines

Wagon Tracks, the journal of the Santa Fe Trail Association (SFTA), publishes well-researched and documented articles relating to the Santa Fe Trail. Articles should contribute new information to the body of knowledge about the Trail, and will be peer-reviewed. **Consult the past article index on the website under the PUBLICATIONS tab and recent issues to verify that your topic hasn't been covered.** *Wagon Tracks* is published in February, May, August and November. Deadlines are the 10th of the month prior to publication. Queries are welcome and may be addressed to editor@santafetrail.org or Ruth Friesen, 505-681-3026.

Submissions should be typed and double-spaced. Use the *Chicago Manual of Style* for text, bibliography and endnotes. See www.chicagomanualofstyle.org/tools_citationguide.html for citation guidelines. Include your name, address, email, and phone number on the title page. Email submissions are preferred. Include a very brief cover letter in the text of your message and send the manuscript as an attachment, using Microsoft Word 2003 or later version, to editor@santafetrail.org. Mailed manuscripts should be sent to Ruth Friesen, *Wagon Tracks* Editor, 1046 Red Oaks NE, Albuquerque, New Mexico 87122.

Please include a 2-3 sentence author bio for publication. Illustrative photos and artwork accompanying articles are welcome. If e-mailed, send photos and artwork as an attachment, in jpg format. Be sure that you have permission to publish them and include the name of the photographer or publication for photo credit.

By submitting your article, you give the Santa Fe Trail Association (SFTA) one-time permission to publish your article in *Wagon Tracks* and permission for subsequent posting on the SFTA website *Wagon Tracks* archives and other digital media such as the UNM library archives. Although the entire issue of *Wagon Tracks* is copyrighted in the name of the Santa Fe Trail Association, copyright to the article remains in the author's name. Articles may be edited or abridged at the editor's discretion.
